100% reported not sharing a copy of their history book with the national office.

50% are updating and keeping Archives

67% have shared the most recent amendments to the Constitution & Bylaws at a meeting.

83% reported using a variety of prayer styles for meetings, others used programs from the National Website, organized retreats and days of reflection.

100% reported sharing information from Catholic sources, websites, catechism of the Catholic Church.

Participation in the World Day of Prayer, Praying the Rosary on Canada Needs Our Lady. Honouring deceased members and honouring our Lady of Good Counsel on April 26th were some of the interfaith activities celebrated at parish levels.

Most of the items addressed were covered in our March Workshops

The overall report shows councils working very well to keep their membership healthy, growing in their faith, and serving others.
